

## Requirements To Progress Through Module 3

*After you attend Module One, this homework must be completed before you will earn your certificate. Use this checklist to help you stay on track. Please reach out if you'd like support!*

- Do 5 session series on 5 horses** (25 sessions total)

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## After Module Three

Once you have satisfactorily completed all the above requirements, you are eligible to take the NBCAAM national certification exam. Here are the steps for your exam:

- 1) Send an email to [office@equinenaturalmovement.com](mailto:office@equinenaturalmovement.com) and let us know you're ready to take the test; we'll send you your transcript and you can use that in the next step.
- 2) Visit [NBCAAM.com](http://NBCAAM.com) and go to "Get Certified" - you'll apply to take the exam, which will include selecting a date and sending them your transcript.
- 3) Once you pass the exam, send an email to us and let us know!

- 4) NBCAAM registers you as a nationally certified Equine Massage Practitioner.

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## WASHINGTON Practitioners
